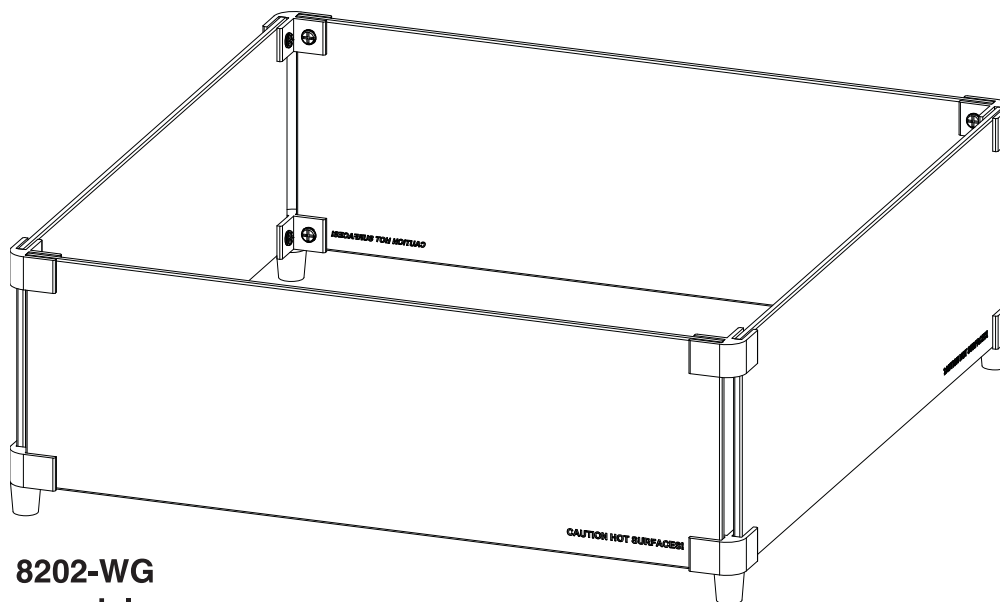

Square Dining Model: 8210-WG



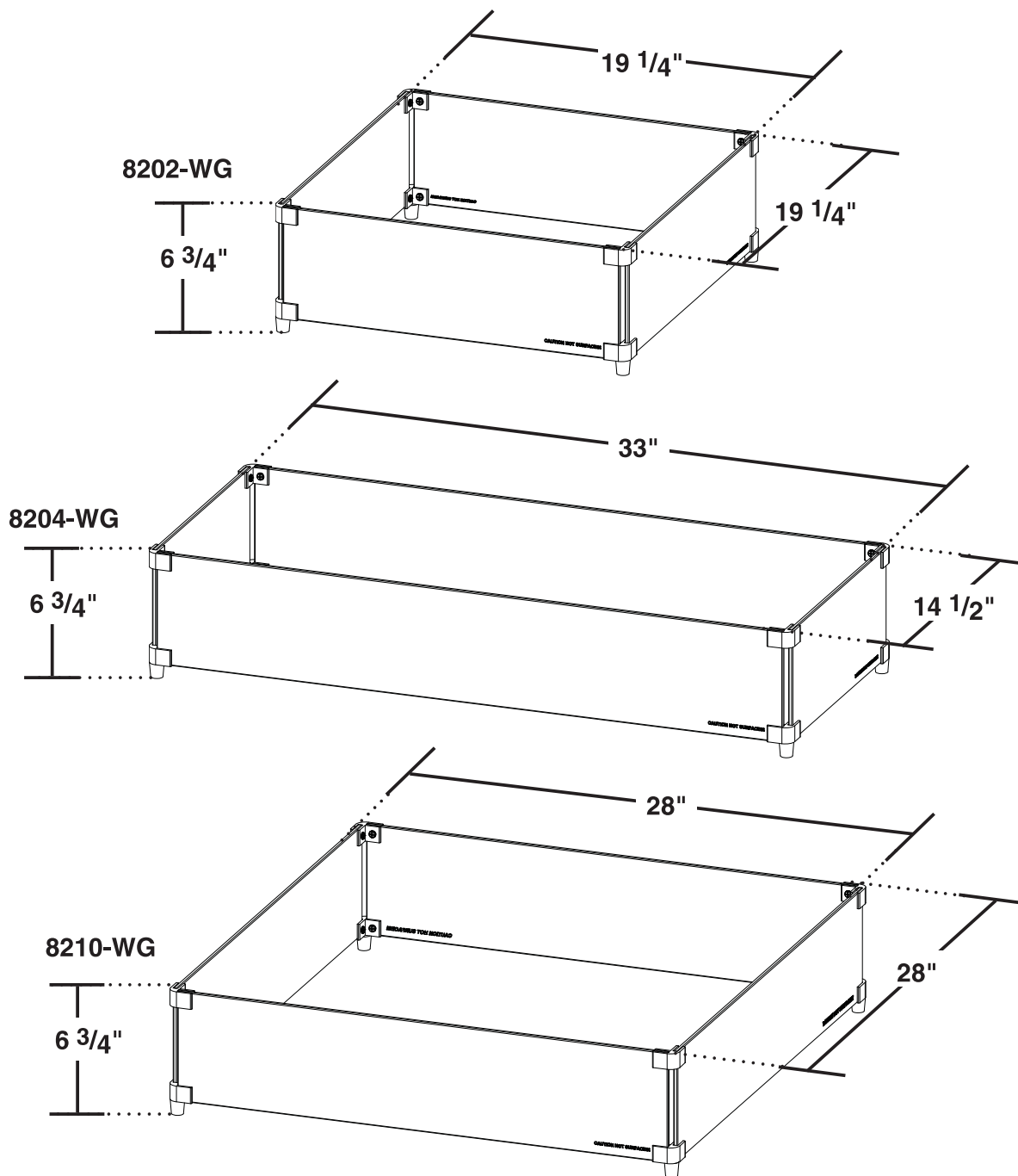

SPECIFICATIONS AND DIMENSIONS

This wind guard is for use with your American Fyre Designs firetable.

CAUTION: DO NOT touch any part of this accessory during operation or when HOT! The glass panels and other surfaces get HOT and can cause burns if touched.

Be sure the firetable and this accessory are completely cool when handling.



TOOLS REQUIRED

- Phillips screwdriver
- 2 assemblers recommended
- Soft cotton gloves for handling glass panels

Note: Use a soft non-abrasive surface for assembly to prevent any damage.

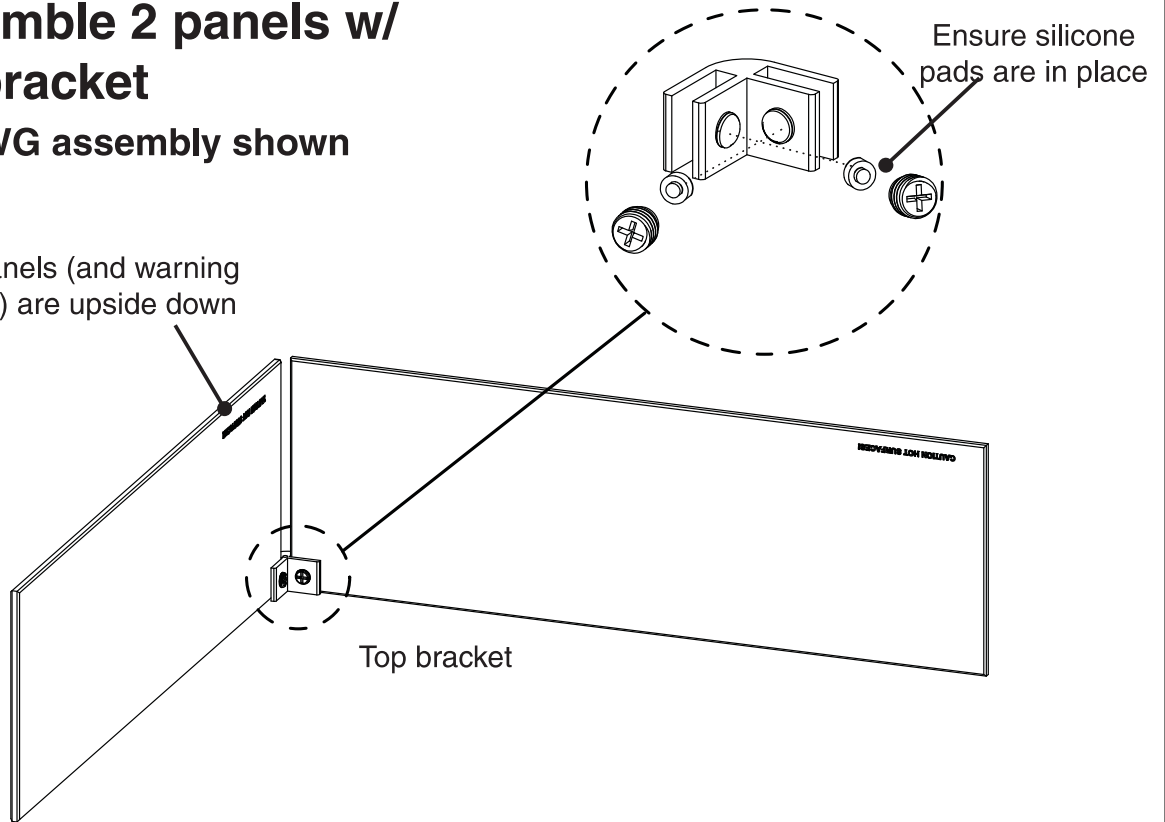

1 Assemble 2 panels w/ top bracket

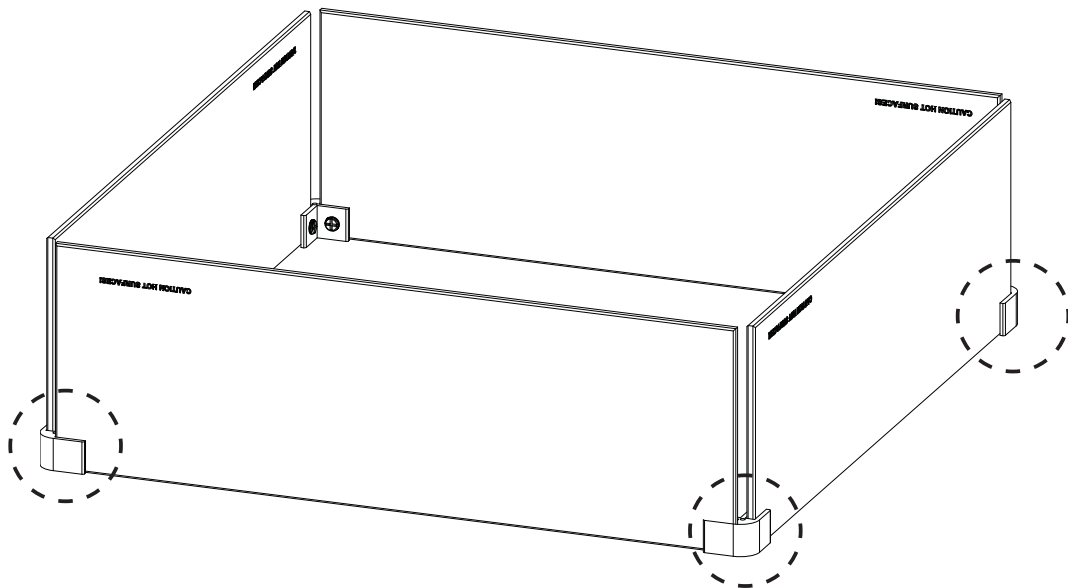
8202-WG assembly shown

etchings) are upside down



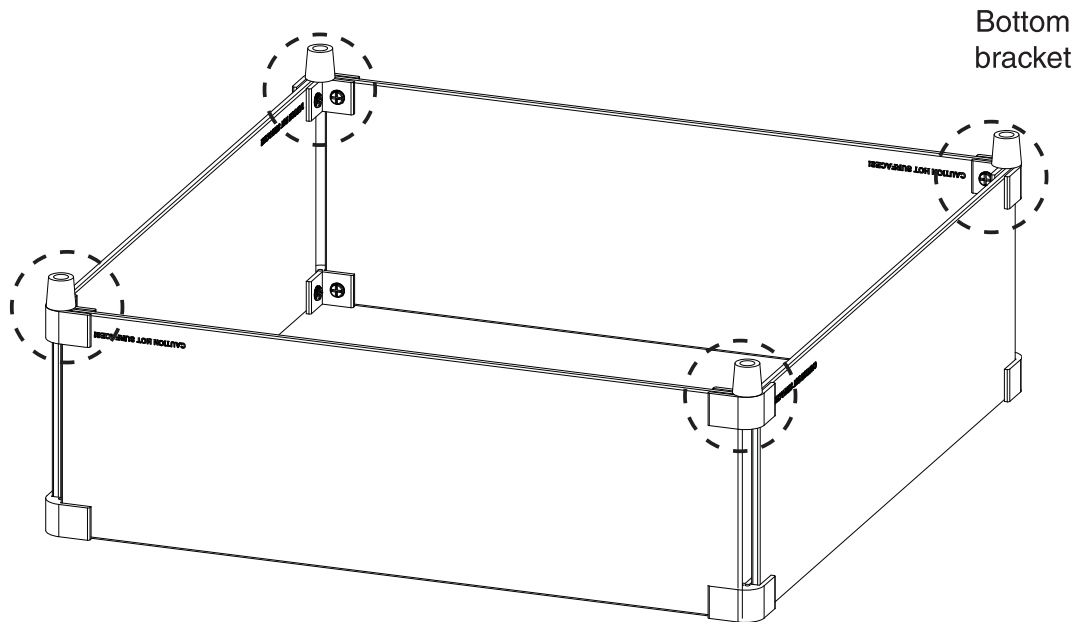
Assemble upside down (as shown) for ease of assembly.

2 Assemble all panels w/ remaining top brackets



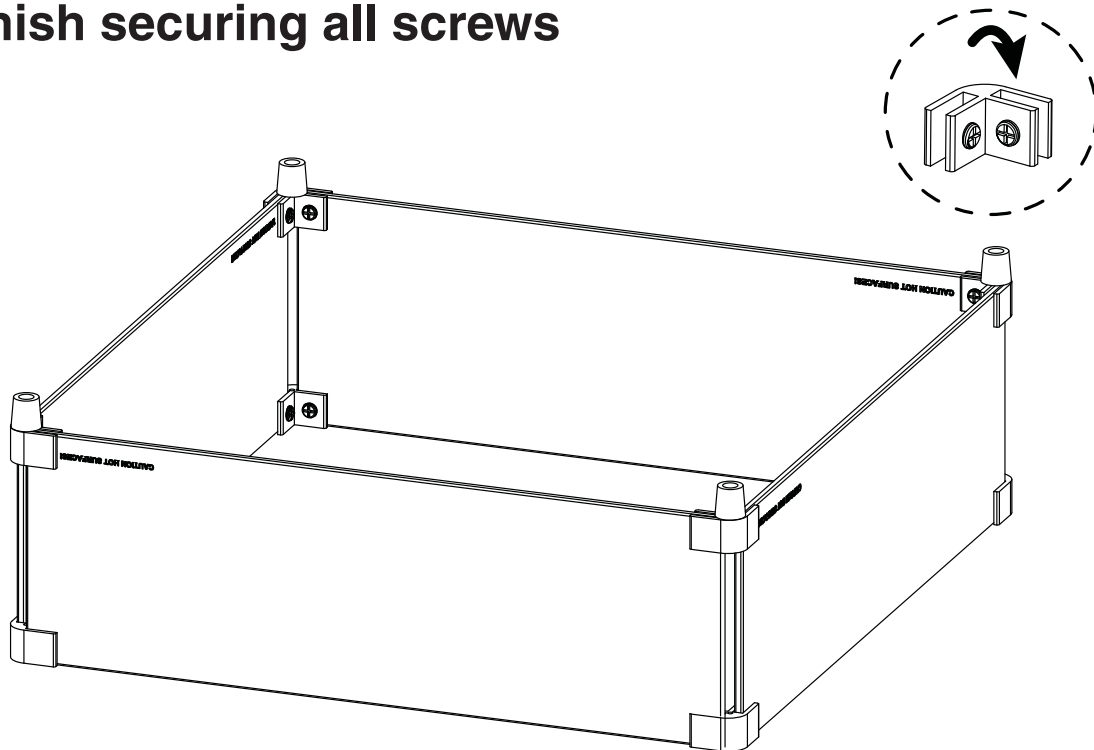
DO NOT overtighten screws. Tighten until snug. Overtightening can break glass.

3 Install bottom brackets



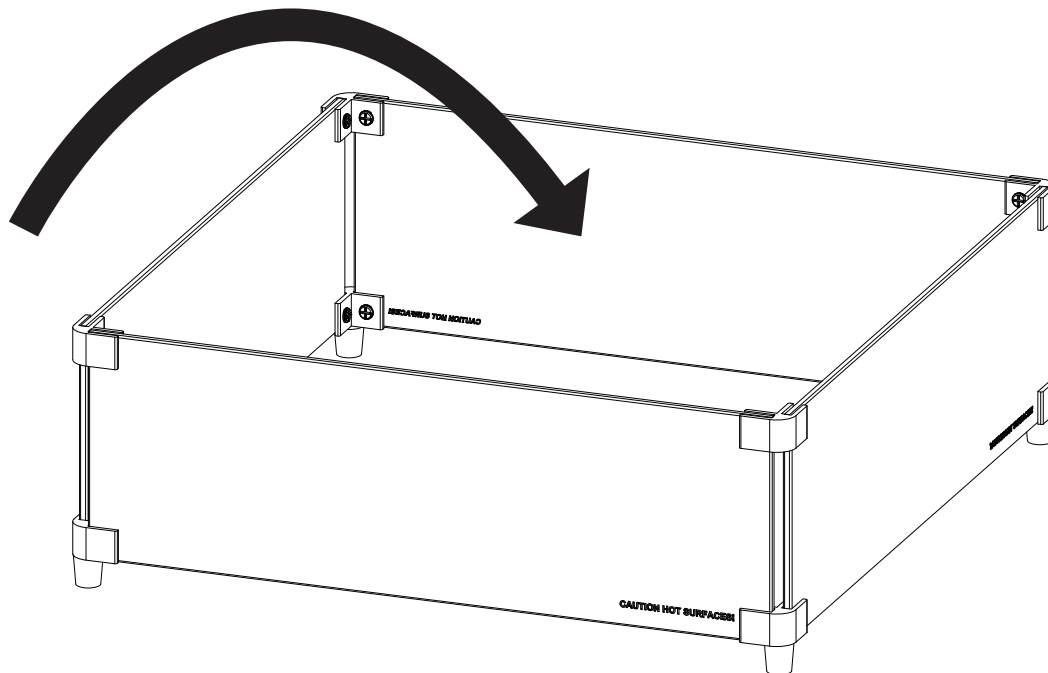
DO NOT overtighten screws. Tighten until snug. Overtightening can break glass.

4 Finish securing all screws



Gently secure all screws (on all brackets) 1/4" to 1/2" turn until panels are secure. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.

5 Install on firetable



Flip and position wind guard on firetable.

CARE AND CLEANING

- Clean the glass periodically to remove any build-ups caused by the elements and combustion. It is recommended that the glass be cleaned 2-3 times during each heating season, depending on use and environment conditions.
- Clean using a non-abrasive glass cleaner and a clean lint-free cloth.
- Never attempt to clean glass while hot.
- DO NOT touch glass while in operation or within 10 minutes following use.
